Will check with Ms. Garcia if she is willing to coordinate/handle again. Michelle stated only two people are needed per day and should consider changing the time to end sooner. The person will keep a log of all items sold on the spreadsheet provided.

The Spring Carnival will be held on Saturday, April 26 and further details will be discussed at the next meeting. Comments made is to recruit more volunteers and order prizes by March. Last year this event raised about \$6,000.

Chocolate Bar Sales possibly March 17-31, Shannon will contact the representative to verify and confirm dates. Need to have a better tracking system and Sandra will be contacted as she coordinated last year and had a suggestion to better handle this fundraiser.

Funds all ready in place is for AR at \$1700, supplies will be ordered a little at a time and computers at \$5000 for an entire lab to function properly.
